## **Apprenticeships**

Apprenticeships are a great opportunity for learners to work for a real employer, earn a salary and achieve a recognised qualification while gaining invaluable work experience and skills. To support learners who are interested in gaining an apprenticeship, we hold two after school sessions in January.

The first session was very successful with learners experiencing what an assessment centre activity is like and gaining some useful tips and guidance to give them an advantage when they come to apply for employment or an apprenticeship.

The second session is on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> January from 3pm -4pm in The Link and supports learners with the application process and setting up accounts on the apprenticeship website: <u>https://www.gov.uk/apply-apprenticeship</u>. Those learners who are attending should go straight to the Link after Period 4.

Many of the learners who attended these sessions last year, went on to secure apprenticeships with some successful employers.

Entry requirements for apprenticeships do vary and depend on the individual company. Many are looking for GCSEs grade 5 or above including Maths and English but not all. Employers will also look at attendance and punctuality and will contact school for a reference. Realistically, most apprenticeships that are open to school leavers are advertised from around March onwards, although some of the bigger companies will open their schemes earlier as they have a more rigorous application process. BMW Group have just opened their scheme for an August 2023 start.

Most apprenticeships are advertised on the government's website - <u>https://www.gov.uk/apply-apprenticeship</u>. Learners need to create an account which allows them to search and apply for any vacancies that they are interested in. Learners can set up email or text alerts for new vacancies.

We must, however, stress that apprenticeships can be competitive so we suggest that learners also apply to college or sixth form as a back-up.
