Dear Parents/Carers,

As the school year is coming to its close, I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your continuing support of Lyndon School through what has been another demanding year of change. As I write to you, we are actively finalising our planning for the year ahead and I am excited at the developments scheduled for our learners upon their return in the autumn term. The current school term will end on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2024 and all learners will be dismissed at 3.00pm.

The new academic year will start following the summer break and will commence on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September for all learners. To support our new learners in Year 7 to settle in we will be staggering the start of the school day as follows:

- Year 7 and Year 11 will need to be in school and in perfect uniform by 8:30 am.
- Years 8, 9 and 10 will need to be in school and in perfect uniform by 10:40 am.

Please be reminded that our uniform expectations also relate to piercings and jewellery. All learners are permitted one simple pair of metal studs (no gems or diamante) in the lobe of the ear. Other piercings are not permitted, and learners will be asked to remove these should they be in on the return to school. Similarly, only natural hair colours are permitted; therefore, please ensure that all learners return to school with natural-looking hair.

On Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2024 - all learners will need to be in school and in perfect uniform by 8:30am and will follow the academy week as listed below:
