What is Unifrog?




- Destinations where learners end up after they leave school is as important for learners as their academic performance. Unifrog partner with schools to support learners to progress into the best opportunities for them.

Apprenticeships






- Learners can find live apprenticeship vacancies

Special Opportunities




- Includes £5 million-worth of grants, bursaries, scholarships, contextual offers and extracurricular activities

- Unlimited shortlists can be created and referred back to






How does my child access Unifrog?

- A link has been sent to their school email address (please check junk/spam mailboxes).
- Click the link and follow the instructions.
- Create a memorable password.
- Make a note of your password.



How does my child access Unifrog?
